

Houston Early Music's Covid-19 Policy 2021-22 Season

Houston Early Music will require audience members to abide by all venue requirements throughout the year. Any ticket holder who does not comply may be required to leave the theater, and their ticket will not be refunded.

It is recommended that patrons not attend events if exhibiting any of the following symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 F (38.0 C)
- Known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19.

- 1. All patrons must wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status, while inside the building and are encouraged to provide their own mask. For those without, masks will be available at the door.

- 3. Seating in the hall is General Admission. Social distancing is encouraged amongst patrons.
